What is Health Care for the Homeless in Santa Fe?

We are a federally granted program through La Familia Medical Center that provides outpatient primary health care, dental care, case management, and referral services. Health Care for the Homeless (HCH), conducts medical clinics throughout the week at our main site as well as other accessible locations in the community.

HCH case managers assist our homeless patients with everything from their medical needs to a sleeping bag or socks. We also assist with referrals to mental health and substance abuse services.

The Four Basic Elements For H

1 Medical Services

Our medical team conducts walk-in clinics Monday through Friday at our main clinic location. Homeless individuals can easily access our services on a walk-in basis. The Services Include:

- Outpatient primary health care
- Specialty physician referrals
- Follow-up care after a hospital stay or emergency room visits
- Dental care referrals

2 Case Management

Our Case Managers assist our patients with information about community services including:

- Referrals for drug and alcohol rehabilitation services
- Referrals for mental health services
- Medical case management services
- Personal hygiene items and sleeping bags when available
- Links to other community agencies for needed services

3 Street Outreach

Our Street Outreach Case Managers cruise the streets and the arroyos in search of those who are in need of assistance and /or information. Homeless individuals are informed of our clinic while we offer them a bottle of water. Case Managers also provide information on where to find food, clothing shelter, and warm showers.

4 Linkages

In order to better serve the homeless population of Santa Fe County, Health Care for the Homeless partners with other social service agencies that assist with the needs of this diverse community.

Giving a helping hand, saying a kind word, and offering encouragement are at the heart of our philosophy.
